Program Policies

1. Program fees are as following:
 \$320.00 fee for first child
 \$250.00 fee for siblings
 You can break the fee down to two payments. If you need more than 2 payments, please see Jackie.
2. Each child must have a completed, notarized release form on file before they may leave the campus with the group. (Erin Dodd is a public notary here at Highland View and can notarize the form for you). The form is attached to the last page of this packet.
3. Children need to be here by 9:00 a.m. and no later. Since the group will be visiting different places, it is important for everyone to be on time so they can leave and get to the day's destination on time. Children should be picked up by 1:50 p.m.
4. Each child should bring a lunch and drink each day to Summer Safari. Since the children will be traveling some days to different locations, you may want to send a small cooler or insulated lunch box.
5. On pool days, your child will need a towel and any pool necessities. For your peace of mind, there are always lifeguards on duty as well as our Summer Safari leaders to keep an eye on the children.
6. We recommend applying sunscreen on your child EACH morning before Summer Safari. You can find long lasting, waterproof sunscreen. Our leaders will also be helping children reapply sunscreen during the day. We want happy, comfortable children each day!
7. We want the Summer Safari program to be a positive experience for all children involved! If discipline problems arise that cannot be handled by the Summer Safari leaders, however, YOU will be required to come pick your child up at the site. Our leaders have an important responsibility taking care of the entire group and will not be expected to deal with repeated discipline problems.
8. You are always welcome to accompany the children on any outing. Let Jackie or the leaders know of any date you would be interested in joining the Summer Safari.
9. We will be taking the churches van this summer unless it is being used otherwise. Some children and sometimes all children will be riding in the leaders' personal

vehicles. Each child will be assigned to a leader's car (or van) and that is who they will ride with the remainder of the summer unless they have a substitute in their place. If your child requires riding in a booster seat, please leave it at the front desk with your child's name on it.
