Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Matthew 3:11 (ASV) I indeed baptize you in water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall **baptize you in the Holy Spirit and *in* fire:**

Note: one preposition (in) governs both objects—Holy Spirit and fire. One event.

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Acts 1:3-5 (ASV) 3 To whom he also showed himself alive after his passion by many proofs, appearing unto them by the space of forty days, and speaking the things concerning the kingdom of God: 4 and, being assembled together with them, he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father, which, *said he*, ye heard from me: 5 **For John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized in the Holy Spirit not many days hence.**

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Matthew 3:11 (ASV) I indeed baptize you in water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you **in the Holy Spirit and *in* fire:**

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Acts 2:1-4 (ASV) 1 And when the day of Pentecost was now come, they were all together in one place. 2 And suddenly there came from heaven a sound as of the rushing of a mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. 3 And there appeared unto them **tongues parting asunder, like as of fire; and it sat upon each one of them.** 4 **And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit,** and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Note: the fire identified the baptism in the Holy Spirit.

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Acts 11:15-17 (ASV) 15 And as I began to **speak**, the Holy Spirit fell on them, even as on us at the beginning. 16 **And I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized in the Holy Spirit.** 17 If then God gave unto them the like gift as *he did* also unto us, when we believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I, that I could withstand God?

Joel 2:28-32 (ASV) 28 And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will **pour out my Spirit upon all flesh**; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: 29 and also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days will I pour out my Spirit.

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Mark 1:5-8 (KJV) 5 And there went out unto him **all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem,** and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, confessing their sins. 6 And John was clothed with camel's hair, and with a girdle of a skin about his loins; and he did eat locusts and wild honey; 7 And preached, saying, There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose. 8 I indeed have baptized you with water: but he shall baptize **you with the Holy Ghost.**

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

“falling upon,”

Ezekiel 11:5 (ASV) And the Spirit of Jehovah **fell upon me**, and he said unto me, Speak, Thus saith Jehovah: Thus have ye said, O house of Israel; for I know the things that come into your mind.

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

“resting upon,”

Numbers 11:26 (ASV) But there remained two men in the camp, the name of the one was Eldad, and the name of the other Medad: and the **Spirit rested upon them; and they were of them that were written, but had not gone out unto the Tent; and they prophesied in the camp.**

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

and “coming upon,”

2 Chronicles 24:20 (ASV) And the Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest; and he stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus saith God, Why transgress ye the commandments of Jehovah, so that ye cannot prosper? because ye have forsaken Jehovah, he hath also forsaken you.

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Judges 14:5-6 (ASV) 5 Then went Samson down, and his father and his mother, to Timnah, and came to the vineyards of Timnah: and, behold, a young lion roared against him. 6 **And the Spirit of Jehovah came mightily upon him**, and he rent him as he would have rent a kid; and he had nothing in his hand: but he told not his father or his mother what he had done.

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Judges 14:19 (ASV) And the Spirit of Jehovah came mightily upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon, and smote thirty men of them, and took their spoil

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Acts 10:44-47 (ASV) 44 While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Spirit **fell on** all them that heard the word. 45 And they of the circumcision that believed were amazed, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was **poured out** the gift of the Holy Spirit. 46 For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God. Then answered Peter, 47 Can any man forbid the water, that these should not be baptized, who have received the Holy Spirit as well as we?

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Acts 8:12 (ASV) But when they believed Philip preaching good tidings concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, **they were baptized, both men and women.**

Identification of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Acts 8:13 (ASV) And Simon also himself believed: and being baptized, he continued with Philip; and **beholding signs** and great miracles wrought, he was amazed.

Baptism as a Figure of Speech

Mark 10:35-40 (ASV) 35 And there come near unto him James and John, the sons of Zebedee, saying unto him, Teacher, we would that thou shouldest do for us whatsoever we shall ask of thee. 36 And he said unto them, What would ye that I should do for you? 37 And they said unto him, Grant unto us that we may sit, one on thy right hand, and one on *thy* left hand, in thy glory. 38 But Jesus said unto them, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink the cup that I drink? or to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? 39 And they said unto him, We are able. And Jesus said unto them, The cup that I drink ye shall drink; and with the baptism that I am baptized withal shall ye be baptized: 40 but to sit on my right hand or on *my* left hand is not mine to give; but *it is for them* for whom it hath been prepared.

Baptism as a Figure of Speech

1 Corinthians 12:12-13 (ASV) 12 For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of the body, being many, are one body; so also is Christ.

13 For **in one Spirit were we all baptized into one body**, whether Jews or Greeks, whether bond or free; and **were all made to drink of one Spirit.**

The Purposes of Baptism in the Holy Spirit

1 Corinthians 14:22 (ASV) Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that believe, but to the **unbelieving**: but prophesying *is for a sign*, not to the unbelieving, but to **them that believe**.

Christian Baptism

**The Form of Baptism Based on the
Actual Meaning of the Word**

Christian Baptism

Strong: to *make whelmed* (i.e. *fully wet*); used only (in the N.T.) of ceremonial *ablution*, especially (technical) of the ordinance of Christian *baptism*

Thayer:

- 1) to dip repeatedly, to immerse, to submerge (of vessels sunk)
- 2) to cleanse by dipping or submerging, to wash, to make clean with water, to wash one's self, bathe
- 3) to overwhelm

Christian Baptism

Acts 8:38 (ASV) And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they both went down into the water, both Philip and the eunuch, and he baptized him.

Christian Baptism

Romans 6:4 (ASV) We were buried therefore with him through baptism unto death: that like as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we also might walk in newness of life.

Christian Baptism

Colossians 2:12 (ASV) having been buried with him [Jesus] in baptism, wherein ye were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead.

1 Peter 3:18-22 (ASV) 18 Because Christ also suffered for sins once, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God; being put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit; 19 in which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison, 20 that aforetime were disobedient, when the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water: 21 which also after a true likeness doth now save you, *even* baptism, **not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the interrogation of a good conscience toward God, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ;** 22 who is one the right hand of God, having gone into heaven; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

Christian Baptism

Hebrews 10:19-22 (ASV) 19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holy place by the blood of Jesus, 20 by the way which he dedicated for us, a new and living way, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; 21 and *having* a great priest over the house of God; 22 let us draw near with a true heart in fulness of faith, **having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience:** and having our body washed with pure water,

1 Peter 3:17-22 (ASV) 17 For it is better, if the will of God should so will, that ye suffer for well-doing than for evil-doing. 18 Because Christ also suffered for sins once, the righteous for the unrighteous, that he might bring us to God; being put to death in the flesh, but made alive in the spirit; 19 in which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison, 20 that aforetime were disobedient, when the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water: 21 which also after a true likeness doth now save you, *even* baptism, not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the interrogation of a good conscience toward God, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ; 22 who is one the right hand of God, having gone into heaven; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

Christian Baptism

Jesus referred to his own death as a baptism:

Mark 10:38 (ASV) But Jesus said unto them, Ye know not what ye ask. Are ye able to drink the cup that I drink? or to be **baptized with the baptism** that I am baptized with?

Luke 12:50 (ASV) But I have a **baptism to be baptized with**; and how am I straitened till it be accomplished!

Romans 6:6-7 (ASV) 6 knowing this, that **our old man was crucified with *him***, that the body of sin might be done away, that so we should no longer be in bondage to sin; 7 for he that hath died is justified from sin.

Romans 8:1-2 (ASV) 1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them that are in Christ Jesus. 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus **made me free** from the law of sin and of death.

Christian Baptism

Titus 3:4-7 (ASV) 4 But when the kindness of God our Saviour, and his love toward man, appeared, 5 not by works *done* in righteousness, which we did ourselves, but according to his mercy he saved us, through the **washing of regeneration** and renewing of the Holy Spirit, 6 which he poured out upon us richly, through Jesus Christ our Saviour; 7 that, being justified by his grace, we might be made heirs **according to the hope of eternal life.**

Christian Baptism

Romans 6:3 (ASV) Or are ye ignorant that all we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death.

Christian Baptism

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (ASV) 19 Or know ye not that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit which is in you, which ye have from God? and ye are not your own; 20 for ye were bought with a price: glorify God therefore in your body.

Ephesians 3:1 (ASV) For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus in behalf of you Gentiles,--

Christian Baptism

Colossians 2:11-12 (ASV) 11 in whom ye were also circumcised with a circumcision not made with hands, in the **putting off of the body of the flesh**, in the circumcision of Christ; 12 having been buried with him in baptism, wherein ye were also raised with him through faith in the working of God, who raised him from the dead.

Christian Baptism

Genesis 17:11 (ASV) And ye shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskin; and it shall be a token of a covenant betwixt me and you.

Christian Baptism

Acts 2:46-47 (ASV) 46 And day by day, continuing stedfastly with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread at home, they took their food with gladness and singleness of heart, 47 praising God, and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to them **day by day** those that were saved.
