Welcome to Highland View Church of Christ!

We are diving into Psalm 51 this morning for our lesson from Scripture. It almost does the Psalm injustice in having just one lesson from it. But this Psalm is so powerful because it speaks to the human drama and predicament of our darkest hours. It brings up questions like...

**Does God really know or care about what I am going through?
In the midst of my depression, can I really find God?**

**Can God really forgive me of something so awful?
One of the collective praises that we can share this morning is that God does indeed forgive us of our sins. There is nothing so bad that God cannot forgive. But in order for God to do what He is so good at doing (forgiving and remembering no more!), we have to be honest with our failings, sinful self, and rebellious heart and not blame anyone or anything else. This means that our fellowship is one of joyful accountability that enjoys the freedom of forgiveness. We all stand guilty, then cleansed by the power of the cross! May our hearts reflect that cleansing!**
