Encouragement for the "Inner Life"

All of us have an "inner life." Our thoughts, feelings, emotions, attitudes, conscience, intuition, etc. all comprise that inward existence. The Bible speaks of it as "heart" and "soul."

Toyohiko Kagawa once said, "*I read in a book that a man called Christ went about doing good. It is very disconcerting to me that I am so easily satisfied with just going about.*"

Kagawa was a Japanese Christian who lived from 1888 to 1960. His main concern was Christian action that flowed from Christian doctrine. He believed that the "inner life" provided motivation for Christian action.

I want to encourage you this year for your own inner life. May your time with God, fellow Christians and personal meditation give you the motivation for Christian action!

Let each one of us ask that God give us eyes to see "the good" around us that needs to be done. Offering a "cup of cold water in his name" is easy when it comes from an "inner life" that itself is refreshed with a cup of cold water from the Spirit!
