There is one follow up challenge that I want to share with all of us: because of what Jesus offers us, we are encouraged to invite others to share the invitation!

Practically this means that we to offer a challenge that goes along with our first challenge of the year.

1. First challenge: encourage one person a week.
2. Second challenge: specifically invite one person to accompany you to the assembly each week who is new.

Encouraging and inviting—this is the core of discipleship. When we care enough to reach out to others, we find all kinds of opportunities in congregational life to bring new people.

Invite. Invite. Invite. When we encourage each other to reach out like this, God will bless this as our “labor in the Lord.” Stay tuned for this morning’s sermon!
