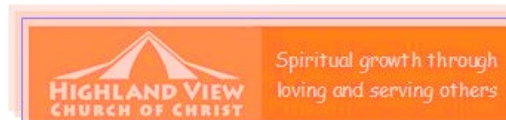

Welcome to Highland View Church of Christ!

The world is built on stories. From cave etchings to AI, humankind has always been built on good storytellers. Think about it: paintings, sculptures, Music, songs, poetry, books, movies, photographs... all instruments in the symphony of Story.

Jesus often used stories to make his points ("the kingdom of Heaven is like..."). The disciples and apostles told stories to spread the Gospel.

This morning I want to look at a story that really struck a chord with me this past week (out of John 4). But what I really hope is to use the story of John 4 to cause each of us to consider our own stories: do we have a story (yes!), what is our story, are we sharing our story, how are we sharing our story, to what end are we sharing our story?

This morning I want you to ask yourselves those Questions. Because, quite frankly,

Your Story Matters
