Welcome to Highland View Church of Christ!

For about a dozen sermons we have been looking at the revealed character of God.

From Genesis to Revelation (we have specifically looked at nearly 20 different books/letters) we have seen that God's character permeates every story, every life, every prophecy, every page, every word. Furthermore, we see that the character of God (the Father) and the character of God's son (Jesus) are, in fact, one and the same!

This morning I want us all to pay close attention to John's words (specifically his "By this..." statements) about who God is AND, therefore, who we are.

Finally, I want all of us (myself included), in light of these 12 weeks on God's character, to closely examine each our beliefs, our convictions, our traditions, our requirements, and our fruit and see if we find anything that contradicts God's revealed character.

If we find something, anything, that we cling to or produce that seems to violate the character of God then we must face that it is not of the Father and we must move our beliefs, attitudes, and actions to be in line with mirroring the character of our creator and our Lord Jesus Christ.
