Diversity of Phraseology in Acts for Conversion

- **2:38** Repent & be baptized
- **2:41** Accepted his message
- **3:19** Repent, turn to God—sins wiped out, times of refreshing may come from the Lord
- **3:26** Turning from your wicked ways
- **4:4** Many who heard message believed
- **5:14** Men & women believed in the Lord
- **5:20** The full message of this new life

Diversity of Phraseology in Acts for Conversion

- **5:31** Jesus might give repentance and forgiveness of sins
- **6:7** priests became obedient to the faith
- **8:12** they believed & were baptized
- **8:13** Simon Magas believed & was baptized
- **8:16** simply been baptized into the name of the Lord Jesus

Diversity of Phraseology in Acts for Conversion

- **8:38** Philip baptized the eunuch
- **9:18, 19** Saul to see again, filled w. Holy Spirit, he got up & was baptized
- **9:35** Turned to the Lord
- **9:42** Many people believed in the Lord
- **10:48** Baptized in the name of Jesus Christ
- **11:1** Gentiles received the word of God
- **11:21** Believed & turned to the Lord

- **13X baptized into something**
- **7x Baptized in the Spirit**
- **1 Corinthians 12:13**
- **Galatians 3:2—receive the Spirit**
