Walk "carefully," circumspectly, --carries the notion of carefully and diligently. See how it is used in Matthew 2:8; Luke 1:3; Acts 18:25.

- "Therefore it says..." what does? What is "it"? Scripture, traditional saying, baptismal liturgy?
- Part of a baptismal hymn?
- Awaking from spiritual slumber
- Spiritual awakening with Christ shining on us
- Romans 13:11-14

BE A WISE WALKER

- Be wise and not unwise
- Making the best use of (redeeming) time—a stewardship perspective, "because the days are evil."
- Do not be foolish

WALK WITH UNDERSTANDING THE LORD'S WILL

- Understanding is vital to the Christian walk
- Understanding the Lord's will
- Implies giving up self-will

WALK-FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT

- Addressing one another (speaking to each other)
- Giving thanks
- Submitting to one another
