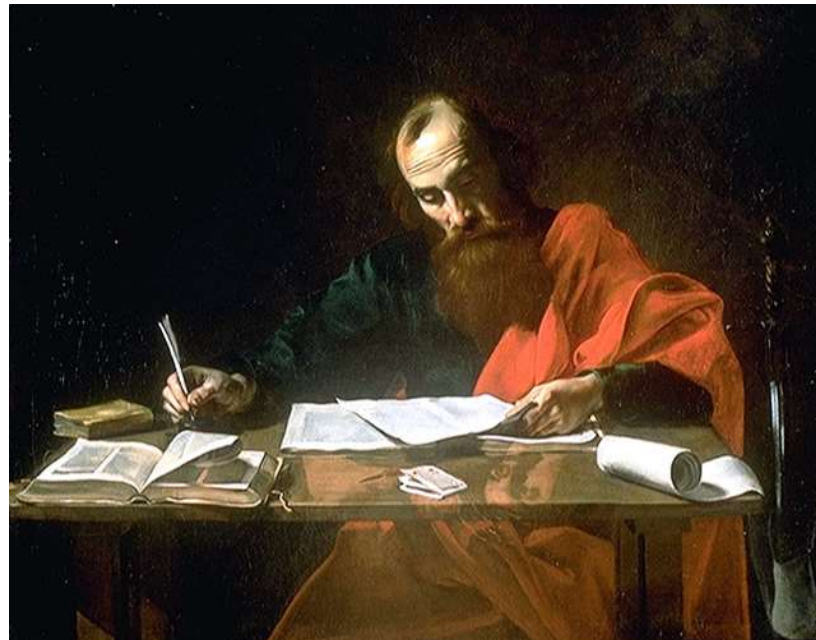

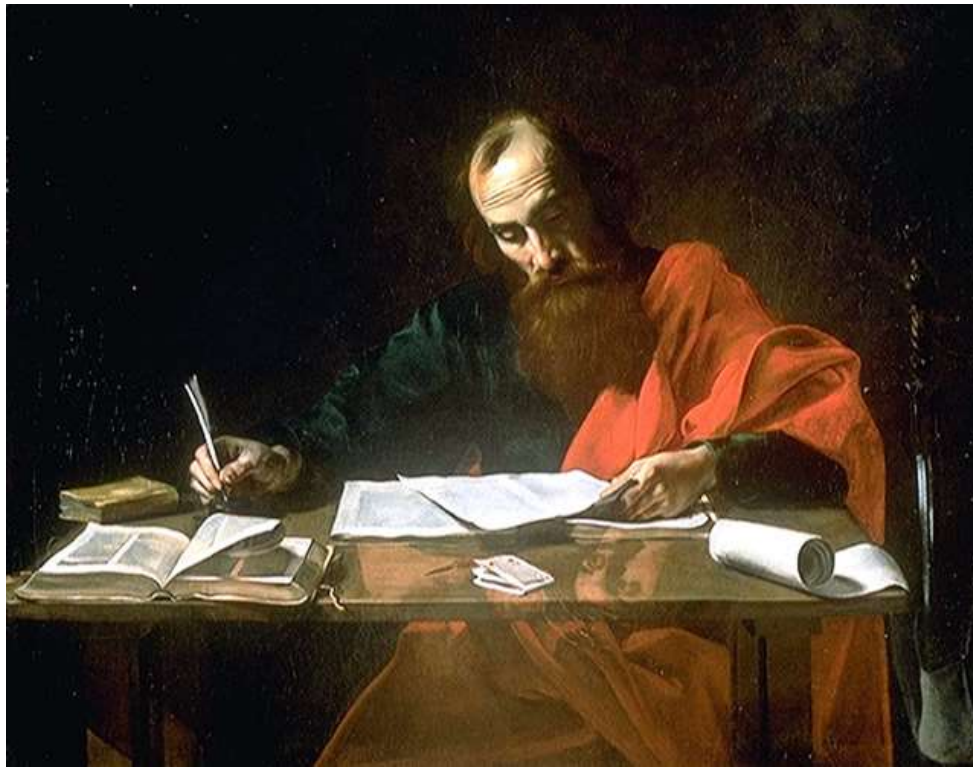
# Acts 20:2
