Welcome to Highland View Church of Christ!

“I will follow you wherever you go.” In Luke’s gospel 3 people said this to Jesus. Actually, one of the three Jesus actually invited them by saying, “Follow me.”

In the narrative of Luke 9:57-62 we meet three nameless individuals: “a man,” “another man,” and “another.” These three anonymous individuals had no idea we would be reading about them 2,000 years later!

In the interchange between Jesus and these three people, one thing is clear: they have a hard time of really counting the cost of following Jesus.

Often, other things take precedent and priority over Jesus’ demanding call of discipleship. I will follow you, Jesus, but first... It is this “but first...” that is the telling clue that something is not right.

Do we say to Jesus on an ongoing basis, “But first...?” Let us encourage one another to say, “Lord, I will follow you first, and no ‘buts’ included.” When we hear Jesus say, “Follow me,” may we have the courage to do it wholeheartedly without other priorities getting in the way!
