## Challenging an Assumption about Church Life

Reading through the gospel of Matthew has challenged many assumptions we hold about church life. One of the clearest assumptions is that church exists for me, and I should be made to feel comfortable with everything I do with my faith. In reality, we learn from the gospel story of Jesus in Matthew that discipleship is always lived on the raw edge of being uncomfortable. Cautious and comfortable are two words that destroy the vim and vigor of discipleship. If a prayer or sermon or passage of Scripture makes me uncomfortable, I need to praise God that the Spirit is using those avenues to keep me on my toes spiritually! Cautious and comfortable are to be replaced with courage and being challenged!
