Last week we discussed some of the frightening, staggering, and humbling statistics of pornography. Perhaps one of the most damning indictments of it all is that the statistics for those outside of the church and the statistics for those who profess to be practicing Christians are nearly identical in every measurable way. I think it is largely because we know that we are no different on this issue that we do not talk about this issue... this silent killer.
