Welcome to Highland View Church of Christ!

Remember last Sunday's challenge? Answer this question: "Why is the pulpit on a raised platform?"

Some sent me emails and text message with the answers of hearing better, seeing better, etc.

Historically, the pulpit came to be raised to demonstrate one of two things...depending on your religious tradition:

1. the authority of the clergy over the laity
2. Or, the authority of Word being preached.

If we still want to claim some symbolic meaning to the raised pulpit, I opt for the second choice above. Here at Highland View we have a tradition of standing out of respect when the Word is read.

Let us think about preaching along the same lines...the speaker stands out of respect for the word. The pulpit and the raised platform symbolizes the place from which a current word from God is being delivered. It is about the Word, it is not about the speaker.

I pray that we never stop finding ways to symbolize our deep respect for Jesus, the Divine Word of God in our reading and preaching!
