Symbols in the Assembly

Symbols have powerful meanings. In our assembly on Sunday morning, several symbols stand out with powerful meanings. The communion table evokes images and memory. Christ is the host around our common table whereby we commemorate and celebrate his life, death, and resurrection.

The pulpit represents respect and authority for the spoken word, whether it is the biblical text being read, prayers being prayed, lessons being presented. Additionally, usually the song leader leads from that position. What ties all of this together is the formative power of the spoken word. We assume, believe and act in response to God speaking through those avenues.

The baptistery behind the pulpit is visible so that we are constantly reminded of our new birth in Christ. It is also visible so that we can as a community of faith witness the new birth of others.

Look around. Communion table, pulpit, baptistery. All three hold deep and significant meanings for our faith being lived out in community. May we constantly "see" these symbols and be reminded of what really matters!
