Collaborative Ministry

The apostle sets the stage for what is called “collaborative ministry” when he says, “[I] appeal to you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive together with me in your prayers to God on my behalf,” (Romans 15:30). This means that ministry is engaged in together as a team effort. Most of the New Testament writers conceive of ministry in all of its forms as a team working to the glory of God.

Paul’s language of “striving together” in prayer is like athletes contending with one another, sharing in a contest. This means working together “with intensity of purpose and in perfect cooperation” for the same goal. This expression is used only here in the New Testament. Interesting that such strong language of effort being exerted together is requested by Paul for prayer! May we collaborate this strongly in all of our efforts of ministry together to the glory of God!
