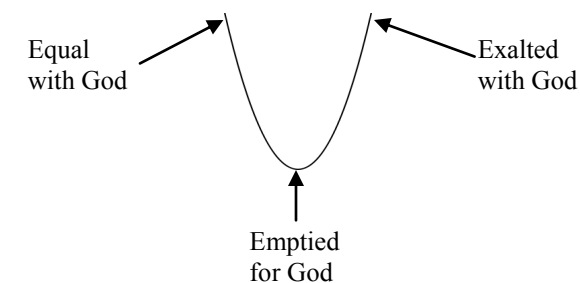

“The Parabola of Salvation”

The shape below is called a “parabola.”



This represents the path of Jesus Christ, going from “equality of God,” emptying himself, coming to earth the form of a servant, and then being raised from the dead, and exalted, seated at the right hand of God.

Tom Long in his commentary on Hebrews calls this action, “The Parabola of Salvation.” Jesus leaves his exalted pinnacle as “Son,” sweeps down into the world in the form of a servant to experience the painful human situation. From there, He is swept back upward, exalted into the very presence of God.

May Jesus’ courage to make this entire journey on our behalf give us hope in our salvation, and a motivation to live the freedom of grace!
