Transaction of our Spirits

A person once wrote that “hymn singing and prayers are the transaction of the (human) spirit with God.” This is an amazing insight into what happens when we assemble.

We do not just sing and pray *to* God. Rather, we are singing and praying *with* God!

We already understand this concept because when we partake of the Lord’s Supper we speak of in it terms of communing with the Lord.
