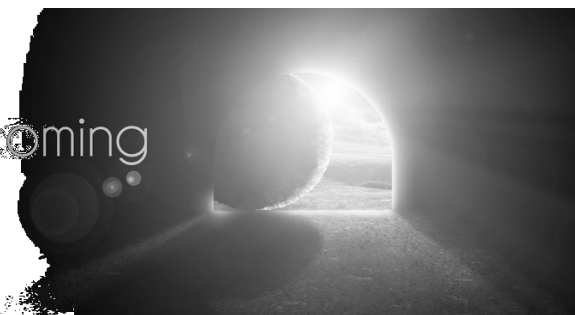

sunday is coming



Jesus went from agonizing prayer, to agonizing betrayal, to not 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5, but 6 "trials". Nothing stuck. What did they hold him for? Because he said he was the son of God ("blasphemy!"). Pilot, wanting nothing to do with it but ending up with Jesus in front of him a second time, gave the crowd what I believe he thought would be an easy choice (for the customary Passover pardoning): Jesus, with whom he could find no fault, or Barabbas, the notorious criminal. The crowd shouted for Barabbas. Jesus was killed. Willingly. He put up no fight. He offered no "defense". He called in no angels. He died. If Jesus had remained in that tomb, had stayed dead, then we wouldn't be here today. Our entire life is based on the resurrection. Everything Jesus had taught and his disciples had believed hinged on the resurrection, that they didn't even know to expect. It is the resurrection, that we celebrate today, that is our hope, or faith, our salvation, our confidence, our certainty, our everything. Why is Pascha/Easter/Resurrection Sunday so important to us? Because it is another opportunity to remember and to celebrate the very crux our Life.
