Welcome to Highland View Church of Christ!

Today we will be looking at Nahum.

Not exactly a book you typically flip to for your daily devotional or one that's every talked about much, at all, really. In reality, Nahum is only about 2 1/2 pages, most of which we will read today.

Nahum makes some people uncomfortable.

Others abuse Nahum, misunderstanding its divine message.

Most of the time when anyone talks about God in the Hebrew Bible, as we have been spending a lot of time on as of late, people will point to "But, what about Nahum!" and use Nahum as proof text (that's the first problem....) for God's "wrath".

So, let's look at Nahum, together, in light of our studies over the last several weeks, and explore what it's really all about and how it fits into our understanding of the character of God (as revealed by God).

Nahum: Father of.... Wrath???
