WHO ARE YOU?

Believe it or not, there are some very funny things that happen in the Bible. One of those has to deal with the question, "Who Are You?" In the book of Acts, chapter 19, verses 13-19 we find the seven sons of Sceva trying to cast out demons in the name of Paul. They said they knew Paul and they knew Jesus but they did not know the sons of Sceva. Then the demons beat the sons of Sceva, tore off their clothes and sent them running into the streets.

When someone asks, "Who are YOU?" How do you reply? Do you simply give your name, or do you try to explain just WHO you are? At times I answer with my name, or the facts that I am a husband, a father, a brother, a son, a teacher, a preacher, or maybe a friend.

The most important person we are is being a Christian, a follower of Jesus Christ. We probably don't answer with that very often, but it is the most important identity we have. It will get us into heaven and make us acceptable to Jehovah. After all, we are not our own, we belong to God, through Jesus Christ! Are YOU a Christian?
