### INTERESTING LESSONS IN THE BIBLE

A few years ago I compiled a series of lessons that were called, "Strange and Unusual Texts" (of the Bible). They included "A Swimming Axe-Head", "A Talking Donkey", "A Walking Dead Man", "What The Blind Man Saw" and "Swallowing the Camel, Humps and All" and a few other interesting subjects. The one we are going to look at today is: "The King Who Ate Grass." It is a lesson that takes place in the time of the prophet Daniel and is about King Nebuchadnezzar.

Years ago my grandfather taught me a little poem about old King Nebuchadnezzar. It goes like this: "Nebuchadnezzar, king of the Jews, he wore sandals and we wear shoes."

I suspect that came from McGuffie's Reader as he often quoted from it. Don't know how it fits, but there you have it, straight from the King who ate grass. (P.S. – This was not the kind of "grass" that is popular to smoke today!)
