Communion is one of the Church of Christ's mainstays.

Our tradition is to take communion (communion/The Lord's Supper/the breaking of bread/the Eucharist) every Sunday morning that we gather together while other churches sometimes take it multiple times per week, some monthly, some quarterly, some annually.

Regardless, each time we take communion, from 1/2 a dozen gathered in a home to 7,000 gathered at a conference, we take the "bread and wine" with saints from all over the world in remembrance of Jesus.

This morning we will take a look into this beautiful tenet: where it came from, what it is, who it is for, how we do it, and (the all important) why.
