Questions for Discussion

Question #1: In the past few months several families have left Highland View. Are the Elders aware of any common elements that caused these families to go to other congregations?

Question #2: 6 of the 11 questions pertaining to leadership received strong positive responses. Do the current Elders plan to take any action to respond to these issues such as adding Elders, Deacons/Ministry Leaders, more public involvement by all Elders, etc.?

Question #3: Do the Elders see any perceived need to alter our current worship service and how it is planned and implemented?

Question #4: The most positive response to the input form was the statement about the need for parents to bring their children to Sunday School. What can Highland View do to reinforce the need for this to happen? What new initiatives can we initiate to revitalize our education program?

Question #5: In the past Highland View has had a very active ministry program. What is being done to reinvigorate this program?

Question #6: The input form showed mixed responses to the questions about the Highland View commitment to missions work. What is the Elders position on the emphasis that should be or should not be placed on missions work both foreign and domestic?

Question #7: What if anything is being done to stimulate cooperation between Highland View and other Churches of Christ in the area?

Question #8: What is the Elders perception of the success of the Small Group Program? What can be done to strengthen the Small Groups, including large group meetings?

Question #9: Are there any plans to make Highland View more visible in the community through advertisements, service programs, support groups and the like?

Question #10: The primary response to the statistical analysis of the congregational input form was several comments about the need for a spiritual renewal within the individual members. What do the Elders plan to do to encourage spiritual renewal within individual members and the congregation at large? What can individual members do?
