COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT: MAKING MATS FOR THE HOMELESS

Ladies of the First Cumberland Presbyterian Church of Oak Ridge makes (sleeping, sitting, etc.) mats for the homeless out of plastic bags. **This class meets every Monday from 2:00-5pm (come and go option) and works on making the mats.** If you are able, please consider taking a Monday afternoon to join them. All mats are taken to TORCH (a resource in Oak Ridge for homelessness) to be distributed. Contact Katherine Steele at 481-6015 with questions. **NOTE:** The mats are crocheted or knitted but if you cannot do either, there are many other things to do to prepare them to be made. There will be something that you can help do. ***If we can get enough interested from Highland View to be involved in this service, then Highland View would like to start our own weekly meeting time to make the mats.***

NOTE: PLASTIC BAGS are very easy to acquire at stores and by others giving them to you. Remember to gather as many as you can for the Food Pantry for bagging the food they give out and for the mats if we are able to start making them. The First Cumberland Presbyterian Church welcomes anyone that wants to join them but they also encourage others to start their own classes and they will be available to help with any questions or concerns we may have about the project.
